Use the following questions this week with family, friends, co-workers, or neighbors to go deeper into what you learned today.

- Acts 28:1-2 reveal the Sovereign hand of God, when He positioned Paul at the right place in His time. Share moments in your life where what you thought was a disruption to your plan revealed an opportunity to either give or receive encouragement.
- Acts 28:3-6 point to a people group that were fickle in their faith because they depended on an experience. How is this evident in our lives today, and why should we be weary of searching for feelings found in an experience instead of faith found in Christ?
- Acts 28:7-10 demonstrate Paul and his company's commitment to care for those in need. Why is it important to meet the physical needs of those around us and how can we use this as a launching pad to proclaim the Gospel?

- Read Matthew 5:14-16 and discuss as a family the impact of a small light in a dark room.
